Dear Foundation Donors:

We are grateful that you are a part of our Foundation family and proud of the many accomplishments last year that were made possible by your support.

Key 2022 financial highlights include:

- The Foundation and its donors distributed **more than \$160 million in grants**.
- We received **more than \$81 million in total donations** and other inflows, and **54 new funds** were established.
- The Foundation's **total assets as of 12/31/22 were \$1.3 billion** (unaudited).

In 2022, we awarded nearly \$6 million in Foundation grants:

- **\$2.5 million in Cutting Edge Grants 2.0** to 10 organizations focused on seeding and growing innovative programs in the Los Angeles Jewish community that address issue areas including antisemitism, Israel and Holocaust education, mental health, Jewish teen engagement, and reaching diverse communities as well as vulnerable populations.
- **\$2.5 million in Israel Grants** to ten organizations in Israel focused on strengthening Jewish engagement and advancing economic development.
- **\$1 million in General Community Grants** to five organizations that support programs providing assistance to low-income older adults through better access to food, healthcare, housing, and supportive care to live independently and to age with dignity.
