We will process all grants received but cannot guarantee grant payments to your selected organization(s) in 2025 if received after the dates outlined above.

Please review your cash balance to ensure adequate funds are available to meet your anticipated grant recommendations for 2025.

If you are invested in the Strategic Return Fund (SRF) or JLens please note that we only liquidate at month-end. To have cash available for December you will need to liquidate shares by November 28.

Initiate stock donations by December 12 to allow time for your broker to complete the transfer and for The Foundation to process it. The IRA Charitable Rollover allows individuals who have reached age 70 ½ to donate up to \$106,000 to charitable organizations directly from their IRA without treating the distribution as taxable income.
