Mental Health

Association of Rape Crisis Centers in Israel (*P.E.F. Israel Endowment Funds*) - A coalition of ten non-profit organizations established to combat sexual violence and serve as an accessible, committed, and independent address for survivors.

Bshvil HaMachar (*American Friends of Bshvil Hamachar*) - Supports Israeli army combat reservists as they navigate the path to healing from the emotional and psychological toll of war.

Israel Conservatory of Music (*P.E.F. Israel Endowment Funds*) - Aims to support returning IDF soldiers and veterans suffering from PTSD through the healing power of music, using 'music as rehabilitation' as its guiding principle.

Metiv (*American Friends of Peace of Mind*) - Dedicated to treating and preventing psychological trauma for individuals affected by conflict and terrorism through evidence-based practices, training, and research.

NATAL (*American Friends of NATAL*) - Offers psychological and emotional treatment and support to victims of trauma due to war and terror.

At-Risk Youth

Dror Israel (*US Friends of Dror Israel*) - Empowers underserved communities through a national network of 1,300+ educators living in Educators' Kibbutzim who deliver impactful educational and social programs in Israel's most challenged neighborhoods.

ELEM (*ELEM US*) - Serves tens of thousands of youths throughout Israel, providing professional counseling, emotional support and individual mentoring.

HaGal Sheli (*Friends of HaGal Sheli*) - Provides educational and therapeutic surfing programs tailored for at-risk youth, trauma survivors, and individuals with disabilities from all corners of Israeli society.

Sunflowers (*P.E.F. Israel Endowment Funds*) - Provides social and emotional support and assistance to orphaned children, youth and adults.

Social Cohesion

aChord (*American Friends of Hebrew University*) - A unique hybrid social-academic organization that develops and disseminates innovative scientific knowledge in social psychology in order to promote equal, tolerant and respectful relations between different social groups within Israel and between Israeli society and its neighbors in the region.

AJEEC-NISPED (*P.E.F. Israel Endowment Funds*) - Combines research and real-world programs to improve relationships between different communities in Israel and the region, using social psychology to promote equality, respect, and understanding.
